1. **Introduction :** This Handout gives information about 3 yr program : B.Sc. (Applied Statistics & Analytics) (Batch 2018)

2. Intake: 40

3. Eligibility Criteria

- 3.1 Candidate must have passed 10 + 2 or equivalent examination from recognized board including International Baccalaureate Diploma (IB certificate or / & DP awarded are **not eligible**) with Mathematics/Mathematics & Statistics as compulsory subject & 50% aggregate marks in any stream (Science/Commerce/Arts with Mathematics).
- 3.2 Candidates of CBSE, ICSE, should mention in online registration / e-admission form (if selected) 10th /10+2 or equivalent aggregate marks of all subjects for which candidate has taken & appeared for (not best of Four, Five, Six or seven). The candidates shall have passed all the subjects appeared for in the applicable examination/s. The aggregate percentage of all subjects for which the candidate has appeared will be taken into consideration for confirming eligibility of the candidate for the program.
- 3.3 In case the mark sheet issued by the applicable Board/Institution is in percentile/s, the actual aggregate percentage of all the subjects appeared by the candidate will be taken into consideration.
- 3.4 Note (for IB & Cambridge Candidate): Candidates called for admission counseling on the basis of merit list & who have not received final marksheet till then will be given Provisional Admission based on predicted score. Fees will be accepted from such candidates but their admission will be confirmed only on submission of final marksheet before the commencement of the program if found eligible.
- 3.5 Submission of AIU equivalence certificate to confirm the eligibility for the program is mandatory for those candidates who have completed their 10+2 or equivalent examination from overseas board/Universities.
- 3.6 Candidates passing 10+2 or equivalent examination from Open or Distance learning (ODL) School recognized only by National Institute of Open schooling (NIOS) can apply for the program subject to fulfilling the eligibility of the program & Candidates who have passed the 10+2 or equivalent examination by doing part-time course or through distance learning/correspondence/externally/open school other than NIOS are not eligible to apply for the courses.
- 3.7 Those candidates who have passed, or, are appearing for 10+2 examination from a Board/University where Grade Point Average is given, such candidates must produce in writing from the Board/University concerned the equivalent percentage for the GPA obtained.
- 3.8 Candidate whose final marksheet is not available at the time of admission is required to submit internet copy of result duly attested by Principal of the school/college, failing which candidate will not be admitted.
- 3.9 Only single marksheet with all compulsory subjects taken and passed in one attempt is mandatory, no compartmentalized marksheet will be considered.
- 3.10 IB Candidates have to enter 'Predicted Scores' in case final grades/ marks are not declared.
- 3.11 Candidate will not be eligible if any subject is marked as ungraded / fail in the marksheet / grade sheet. For absent / Ungraded in any of the additional/non mandatory subject will be consider as eligible provided such candidates is declared as pass by respective board.

3.12 Candidates appearing for their final 10+2 or equivalent examination can also apply provided they obtain the required minimum cut off marks and also produce all the necessary documents, in original, within the given stipulated time.

4. Online registration & Payment of registration fee :

- 4.1 Online registration:
 - Visit <u>www.nmims.edu</u> for online registration
 - Before filling the online form, please read all the instruction carefully mentioned in instruction sheet & important dates
 - 4.2 Payment of registration fee:
 - Pay registration fee of Rs 1000/- (Non refundable) (Please refer online registration for payment details.) Registration fee is non refundable

5. Selection Process:

- Merit list will be based on performance of the candidate in Mathematics/Mathematics & Statistics marks obtained in 10+2 or Equivalent examination.
- The selection will be solely based on merit. In this regard, the decision of the NMIMS will be final and undisputable as also shall be binding on all concerned.

6. Program Fees:

Fees for 2017-18 were Rs.75, 000/- p.a (for information only). Fees for current year will be intimated at the time of admission.

7. **Refund Rules:** The Schedule of refund of fees will be as follows as per UGC rule December 2016:If a student chooses to withdraw from the program of study in which he / she is enrolled, the institution concerned shall follow the following four-tier system for the refund of fees remitted by the student.

Sr. No.	Percentage of Refund of Aggregate fees*	Point of time when notice of withdrawal of admission is served to HEI
(1)	100%	15 days before the formally-notified last date of admission (on or before 9 th July 2018)
(2)	80%	Not more than 15 days after the formally-notified last date of admission(from 10 th July 2018 to 9 th August 2018)
(3)	50%	More than 15 days but less than 30 days after formally-notified last date of admission (10 th August 2018 to 24 th August 2018)
(4)	00%	More than 30 days after formally-notified last date of admission (from 25 th August 2018 onwards)

In case of (1) in the table above, the deduction will be 10% of the aggregate fees as processing charges from the refundable amount. Aggregate fees is inclusive of course fees and non-tuition fees but exclusive of caution money and security deposit.

Note: The above refund rules are subject to revision as per UGC notification (as applicable). Candidates to refer Important Dates of the respective programme.

8. Important Instructions:

- Merit list will be prepared on the basis of the performance of the candidate in 10+2 or equivalent exam Score
 entered at the time of Online Registration. Therefore, its sole responsibility of the candidate to ensure that
 correct marks are entered.
- If at any stage, it is found that a candidate does **not** satisfy the eligibility criteria or the information furnished by him/her in the application form is incorrect i.e 10 +2 or equivalent exam score(Mathematics /Mathematics & Statistics), the candidate admission will be cancelled and fees will be forfeited
- Candidates of IB & Cambridge board will be not be considered for admission /if admitted admission will be cancelled & fees will be refunded as per rule, if 10+2 or equivalent exam Score is less than predicted score mentioned in online registration form & does not fall within cutoff.
- Please see the important dates and preserve it as a guide. All announcements from the NMIMS will be through its web site www.nmims.edu and no individual communication will be sent to the candidate. Kindly check website for regular updates.
- It is the sole responsibility of the candidates to ascertain whether they possess the necessary and requisite qualification for the admission to the courses at NMIMS.
- Canvassing in any form will disqualify the candidate
- Candidates are required for admission process in person.
