1. **Program:** B.Sc. (Applied Statistics & Analytics)

2. Eligibility Criteria

Candidate must have passed 10 + 2 or equivalent examination including IB Diploma (IB certificate awarded is **not eligible**) with Mathematics/Mathematics & Statistics as compulsory subject & 50% aggregate marks in any stream (Science/Commerce/Arts with Mathematics).

Candidate with IB Diploma is eligible only if he/she has offered Mathematics /Mathematics & Statistics at SL/HL

Candidates passing 10+2 or equivalent examination from Open or Distance learning (ODL) School recognized only by National Institute of Open schooling (NIOS) can apply for the program Subject to fulfilling the eligibility of the program & Candidates who have passed the 10+2 examination in part-time mode or through distance learning/correspondence/externally/open school other than NIOS are not eligible to apply for the courses.

Note (for IB & Cambridge Candidate): Candidates called for admission on the basis of merit list & who have not received final marksheet till then will be given "Provisional Admission "based on predicted score. Fees will be accepted from such candidates but their admission will be confirmed only on submission of final marksheet before the commencement of the program if found eligible.

IB Candidates have to enter 'Predicted Scores' in case final grades/ marks are not declared. The Admission will be given on Provisional basis only. In case of Foreign Board, Candidate has to submit AIU equivalence Certificate at the time of Admission, if selected.

Candidates appearing for their final 10+2 or equivalent examination can also apply provided they should obtaining the required minimum cut off marks and also producing all the necessary documents, in original, within the stipulated time by the University

Those candidates who have passed, or, are appearing for 10+2 examination from a Board/University where Grade Point Average is given, such candidates must produce in writing from the Board/University concerned ,the equivalent percentage for the GPA obtained.

Candidates of CBSE,ICSE,Should mention in online application form 10^{th} /10+2 or equivalent aggregate marks of all subjects for which candidate has appeared for (not best of Four,Five,Six or seven)

NMIMS reserves the right to alter the terms of eligibility

6. Selection Process:

Merit list will be based on performance of the candidate in Mathematics/Mathematics & Statistics marks obtained in 10+2 or Equivalent examination.

7. Program Fees:

Fees (Subject to change): Rs.60000/-

8. Refund rules:

The Schedule of refund of fees will be as follows:

1. Till the date of commencement of the Programme. i.e 13 th July 2015	Rs.1000/- will be deducted as administrative charges
2. Cancellation after the official closure of admission. i.e 14 th July 2015	Cancellation made after the official closing of admission, fees will NOT be refunded.

9. Important Instructions:

- Please see the important dates and preserve it as a guide. All announcements from the University will be through its website www.nmims.edu and there will be no separate mail sent.
- Merit list will be prepared on the basis of the performance of the candidate in 10+2 or equivalent exam Score entered at the time of Online Registration. Therefore, its sole responsibility of the candidate to ensure that correct marks are entered. At any given point of time it is found that the information given by candidate i.e 10 +2 or equivalent exam Score is incorrect, the candidate admission will be cancelled and fees will be forfeited
