- **1. Introduction :**This Handout gives information about "5 year Integrated M.Sc. in Biomedical Science" program (Batch 2020)
- 2. Intake: 25

3. Eligibility Criteria

- 3.1 Candidate must have passed 10 + 2 or equivalent examination from recognized board with Biology as compulsory subject & 60% aggregate marks in Science stream.
- 3.2Candidates of CBSE, ICSE, should mention in online registration / e-admission form (if selected) 10th /10+2 or equivalent aggregate marks of all subjects for which candidate has taken &appeared for (not best of four, five, six or seven). The candidates should have passed all the subjects appeared for in the applicable examination/s. The aggregate percentage of all subjects for which the candidate has appeared will be taken into consideration for confirming eligibility of the candidate for the program at time of admission.
- 3.3In case the mark sheet issued by the applicable Board/Institution is in percentile/s, the actual aggregate percentage of all the subjects appeared by the candidate will be taken into consideration.
- 3.4Note (for IB & Cambridge Candidate): Candidates called for admission on the basis of merit list & who have not received final marksheet till then will be given provisional admission based on predicted score. Fees will be accepted from such candidates but their admission will be confirmed only on submission of final marksheet before the commencement of the program if found eligible.
- 3.5Submission of AIU equivalence certificate to confirm the eligibility for the program is mandatory for those candidates who have completed their 10+2 or equivalent examination from overseas board/Universities.
- 3.6Those candidates who have passed, or, are appearing for 10+2 examination from a Board/University where Grade Point Average is given, such candidates must produce in writing from the Board/University concerned the equivalent percentage for the GPA obtained.
- 3.7Candidate whose final marksheet is not available at the time of admission is required to submit internet copy of result duly attested by Principal of the school/college, failing which candidate will not be admitted.
- 3.08IB Candidates have to enter 'Predicted Scores' in case final grades/ marks are not declared.
- 3.9 Only single marksheet with all compulsory subjects taken and passed in one attempt is mandatory, no compartmentalized marksheet will be considered.
- 3.10Candidate will not be eligible if any subject is marked as ungraded / fail in the mark sheet / grade sheet. For absent / ungraded in any of the additional/non-mandatory subject will be consider as eligible provided such candidates is declared as pass by respective board.
- 3.11Candidates appearing for their final 10+2 or equivalent examination can also apply provided they obtain the required minimum cut off marks and also produce all the necessary documents, in original, within the given stipulated time.

3.12 A candidate who has passed 10+2 or equivalent examination from IB Board should be either IB certificate or DP awarded with 24 credits compulsory, having passed 3 HL with minimum (12 credits) & 3 SL with minimum (9 credits) mandatorily from any stream.

4. Online registration & Payment of registration fee:

4.2 Payment of registration fee:

• Pay registration fee of Rs1000/- (Non-refundable) (Please refer online registration for payment details.) Registration fee is non-refundable

5. Selection Process:

- Merit list will be based on Biology marks obtained in 10+2 or equivalent examination and additional 5 marks for those who scored 60% and above in Chemistry subject.
- The selection will be solely based on merit. In this regard, the decision of the NMIMS will be final
 and undisputable as also shall be binding on all concerned.

6. Program Fees:

Fees for 2019-20 were Rs.1,01,500/- p.a (for information only). Fees for current year will be intimated at the time of admission.

7. Refund Rules: Refund Rules: If a student chooses to withdraw from the program of study in which he / she is enrolled, the institution shall follow the following five-tier system for the refund of fees* remitted by the student.

| Sr. No. | Percentage of Refund of Fees* | Point of time when notice of withdrawal of admission is received in the Higher Educational Institutions (HEI) |
|------------|----------------------------------|---|
| (1) | 100% | 15 days or more before the formally-notified last date of admission (13th July 2020) |
| (2) | 90% | Less than 15 days before the formally-notified last date of admission (14th July 2020 to 29th July 2020) |
| (3) | 80% | 15 days or less after the formally-notified last date of admission (30th July 2020 to 13th August 2020) |
| (4) | 50% | 30 days or less, but more than 15 days, after formally-notified last date of admission (14th August 2020 to 28th August 2020) |
| (5) | 00% | More than 30 days after formally-notified last date of admission (29th August 2020 onwards) |

In case of (1) in the table above, the HEI concerned shall deduct an amount not more than 5% of the fees paid by the student, subject to a maximum of Rs. 5,000/- as processing charges from the refundable amount.

Note: Candidates to refer Important Dates of the respective programme.

The above refund rules are as per University Grants Commission (UGC) notification on Refund of Fees and Non-Retention of Original Certificates of October, 2018 and are subject to revision as per UGC notification (as applicable). Please note the closure of admission/last date of admission as mentioned in the refund is Wednesday, 29th July, 2020.

8. Important Instructions:

- Merit list will be prepared on the basis of the performance of the candidate in 10+2 or equivalent exam. Therefore, its sole responsibility of the candidate to ensure that correct marks are entered for Chemistry and Biology at the time of online registration.
- If at any stage, it is found that a candidate does **not** satisfy the eligibility criteria or the information furnished by him/her in the application form is incorrect i.e 10 +2 or equivalent exam Score (Chemistry and Biology),
 - the candidate admission will not be considered & if found admitted it will be cancelled and fees will be refunded as per prescribed refund rules.
- Candidates of IB & Cambridge board will not be considered for admission /if admitted admission will be cancelled& fees will be refunded as per rule, if 10+2 or equivalent exam score is less than predicted score mentioned in online registration form & does not fall within cutoff.
- Please see the important dates and preserve it as a guide. All announcements from the NMIMS will be through its web site www.nmims.edu and no individual communication will be sent to the candidate. **Kindly check website for regular updates.**
- It is the sole responsibility of the candidates to ascertain whether they possess the necessary and requisite qualification for the admission to the courses at NMIMS.
- For cancellation/ withdrawal of admission: Withdrawal /cancellation means voluntary withdrawal/cancellation by
 candidate for any reason. Candidate should email at admissioncancellation@nmims.edu,the soft copy of admission
 cancellation form duly filled and signed (available on www.nmims.edu (https://www.nmims.edu/students/, fee paid
 receipt copy & cancelled cheque (personal account).
- Canvassing in any form will disqualify the candidate
- Candidate's documents will be verified at the time of admission/commencement of program (if selected) &
 if found not eligible, admission will be cancelled and fees will be refunded as per prescribed refund rule.
