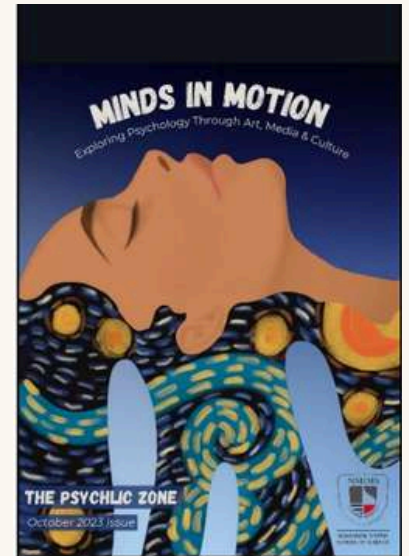
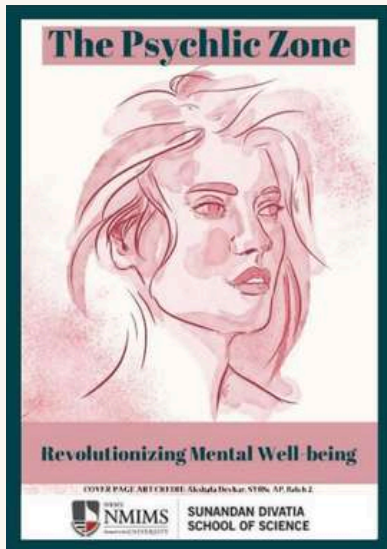
Media Psychology Workshop
