**1. Introduction:** This Handout gives information about 2- year program: M.Sc. (Applied Psychology, Batch 2021) – Mumbai Campus

**2. Intake: 40 Seats**

**3. Eligibility Criteria:**

- Candidates should have secured minimum 55% or equivalent in the bachelor degree in Science i.e. B. Sc. from any recognized university in Science Stream, Engineering, Technology, Medicine, Pharmaceutical Science, or B.A. in Psychology from faculty of Arts and Humanities shall be eligible for Master of Science course.

**4. Online registration & Payment of registration fee:**

**5. Selection Process:**

Merit list will be based on Personal interview.

**6. Program Fees:** (for information only)

Program fees for 1<sup>st</sup> year M.Sc. (Applied Psychology), Batch 2021 is Rs. 1,10,000/-

**7. Refund Rules:** If a student chooses to withdraw from the program of study in which he/ she is enrolled, the institution shall follow the following five-tier system for the refund of fees\* remitted by the student.

Sr. No.	Percentage of Refund of Fees*	Point of time when notice of withdrawal of admission is received in the Higher Educational Institutions (HEI)
(1)	100%	15 days or more before the formally-notified last date of admission
(2)	90%	Less than 15 days before the formally-notified last date of admission
(3)	80%	15 days or less after the formally-notified last date of admission
(4)	50%	30 days or less, but more than 15 days, after formally-notified last date of admission
(5)	00%	More than 30 days after formally-notified last date of admission

In case of (1) in the table above, the HEI concerned shall deduct an amount not more than 5% of the fees paid by the student, subject to a maximum of Rs. 5,000/- as processing charges from the refundable amount.

Note: Candidates to refer Important Dates of the respective programme.

The above refund rules are as per University Grants Commission (UGC)

**8. Important Instructions:**
