1. **Program:** M.Sc. (Applied Statistics & Analytics)

2. Eligibility Criteria

The candidate must hold a bachelor's degree in any stream with minimum 60% aggregate marks or a minimum CGPA of 3 out of 4.

And

The candidate must have passed 10 + 2 or equivalent examination including IB Diploma with Statistics /Mathematics/ Mathematics & Statistics as a compulsory subject with minimum 60% marks in the subject. Candidate with IB Diploma is eligible only if he/ she has offered Statistics /Mathematics/ Mathematics & Statistics at SL/ HL.

A candidate who has passed 10+2 or equivalent examination from IB Board should be either IB certificate or DP awarded with 24 credits compulsory, having passed 3 HL with minimum (12 credits) & 3 SL with minimum (9 credits) mandatorily from any stream.

Note:

- Candidates awaiting the results of the Final year graduation examination may also apply.
- All Eligible candidates would have to appear for a Written Examination conducted at NMIMS, followed by a Personal Interview
- Candidates who have cleared their graduation by doing a part-time course or through distance learning, correspondence courses, externally, open school from recognized University are eligible to apply & register as per UGC guidelines.
- Submission of AIU equivalence certificate to confirm the eligibility for the program is mandatory for those candidates who have completed their Under-Graduation/Graduation from overseas Board/Universities.
- **3. Duration:** 2 years including Internship (Industry)

4. Intake: 40 seats

*Intake subject to change based on availability of number of applicants. Program will commence only if there are a minimum of 10 eligible candidates after the selection process.

7. Program Fees:

Fees for the program: (for 2018) Rs.1,60,000/- (for information only). Fees for 2019 session will be intimated at the time of admission.

8. Refund rules: If a student chooses to withdraw from the program of study in which he / she is enrolled, the institution shall follow the following five-tier system for the refund of fees* remitted by the student.
